They suggested the ways we can help is to: *Call in all violations* immediately. The 800 no. is on your Fishing License. 1-800-352-0700. Provide as many details as you can. Description of the person(s), what are they doing and WHERE, WHAT AND HOW. Example...If using powerbait, during Flies only, what color is the powerbait, this even helps enforcement. A vehicle description and a license number really helps. **CALL IN ALL VIOLATORS BUT NEVER APPROACH THEM.**

October Fish Tales
